



RESIDENTIAL INSULATOR

The Residential Insulator Program is TUITION FREE and prepares eligible participants to work in the booming insulation industry. Insulators are employed by construction companies, insulation contractors and other related businesses.

This 25-week program is designed to provide the necessary hands-on skills to be successful in insulation positions. This training will develop practical skills, provide industry required safety certificates and employability skills related to the residential insulation industry.

This program includes a 10-week work placement with local employers. These placements will provide valuable work-related experience to build on the theory and skills learned in the classroom.

To apply for this tuition-free program, applicants must be:

- Unemployed, under-employed or be employed in work that is not secure
- Attached to Employment Insurance (EI); active claim, past claim in the last five years or paid EI premiums on earnings over \$2,000 in five of the last 10 years
- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- A resident of British Columbia
- Not a student (i.e., enrolled in high school or other post-secondary training)
